**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VIDOR, TEXAS IN SUPPORT OF A PROPOSAL BY ENTERGY TEXAS, INC. FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY POWER STATION IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY**

WHEREAS, on October 7, 2016, Entergy Texas, Inc. ("Entergy") filed an Application to Amend its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to Construct Montgomery County Power Station, a new gas-fired generation facility to be located near Willis, Texas with the Public Utility Commission of Texas ("Commission");

WHEREAS, Entergy believes that the Montgomery County Power Station will provide a \$1.7 billion net benefit to customers over 30 years;


WHEREAS Entergy believes that construction of the Montgomery County Power Station will provide significant economic impact to the State of Texas through the creation of new jobs and \$1 billion in economic activity across the state; and

WHEREAS, the City of Vidor, Texas (the "City") is supportive of Entergy's application and finds that the construction of the Montgomery County Power Station is in the public interest.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council for the City that:**

1. **Adoption of Recitals.** The City finds that the recitals set forth above are incorporated herein for all purposes and are found to be true and correct.
2. **Support of Montgomery County Power Station.** The City hereby affirms its support for the Construction of the Montgomery County Power Station in Montgomery County, Texas.
3. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution is passed is open to the public and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.
4. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage


